Includes access to the **Burns National Heritage Park** (*new for 2009!*), world-class visitor attraction at Culloden Battlefield, the world famous Culzean Castle and Inverewe Garden, as well as over 100 spectacular destinations across Scotland.

Savings

2. Bearers are entitled to unrestricted access to public areas during advertised opening times only. On occasion access may be limited due to essential repairs. Access outwith advertised opening times may incur a surcharge.
3. For some special events or attractions which are not an integral part of the property, an additional charge may be made.
4. Clients unable to produce a valid Discover Ticket or Discover Voucher will be charged the standard admission rate. Such charges are not refundable.
5. Once purchased, tickets cannot be transferred, exchanged or refunded.
6. The National Trust for Scotland reserves the right to refuse admission to any person and to remove persons from the venue for any reason where necessary including, without prejudice to the foregoing generality, health and safety, environmental and security concerns.
7. The National Trust for Scotland or venue management may from time to time and at their sole discretion carry out security searches and you agree to these searches being carried out.

The National Trust for Scotland advises customers that no refunds will be offered to customers who are refused entry or ejected from a property or venue for reasons including late arrival, declining to be searched if appropriate, abusive, threatening, drunken or other antisocial behaviour (including smoking in no smoking areas), causing a nuisance, carrying offensive weapons or illegal substances, or making unauthorised audio, video or photographic recordings.

11. The Trust reserves the right to vary, at its sole discretion and without notice, the opening times, days and inclusion or exclusion of any properties under this scheme without liability or recompense to the ticket holder'.
