The Project Challenge

The Project Challenge provides an opportunity for your organisation to contribute to a major National Trust for Scotland conservation project, and to allow up to 100 or more of your staff a day out of the office and the chance to put something back into their local environment. Project Challenges are non-residential and task-focused, offering organisations the opportunity to put significant numbers of employees through the programme, usually in teams of 12 to 15. This may happen on consecutive days over one or two weeks, though we can just as easily operate over a number of months if this suits your organisation better. These Challenges provide the perfect opportunity for companies to set up a volunteering programme for their employees, and to express their commitment towards their local community and environment. Each project is real and will have a lasting impact, for example building a new adventure playground, footpath or bridge. We can also arrange other add-ons such as an informal reception or barbecue for project staff and their families once the project is complete.
