





Founded in 1991, the band consists of children from the village of Kfar Vradim in northern Israel, and is directed by Reuven Mal'ach, a lawyer, saxophonist, pianist and talented conductor. The band is internationally renowned, having performed in Israel, Hungary, Belgium, Canada and the United States – including at the opening of the Maccabi Games in Detroit in 1998.
